

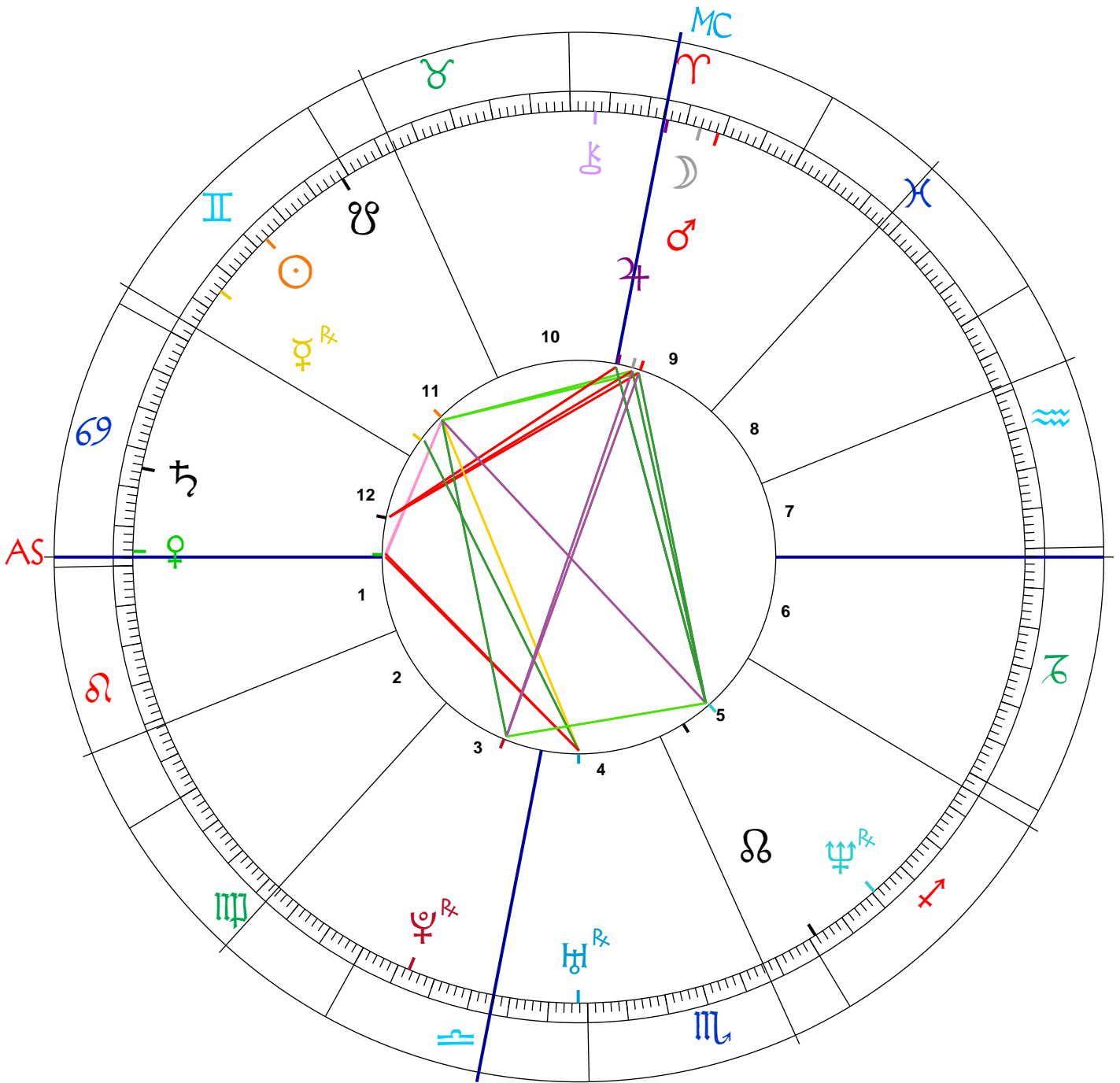

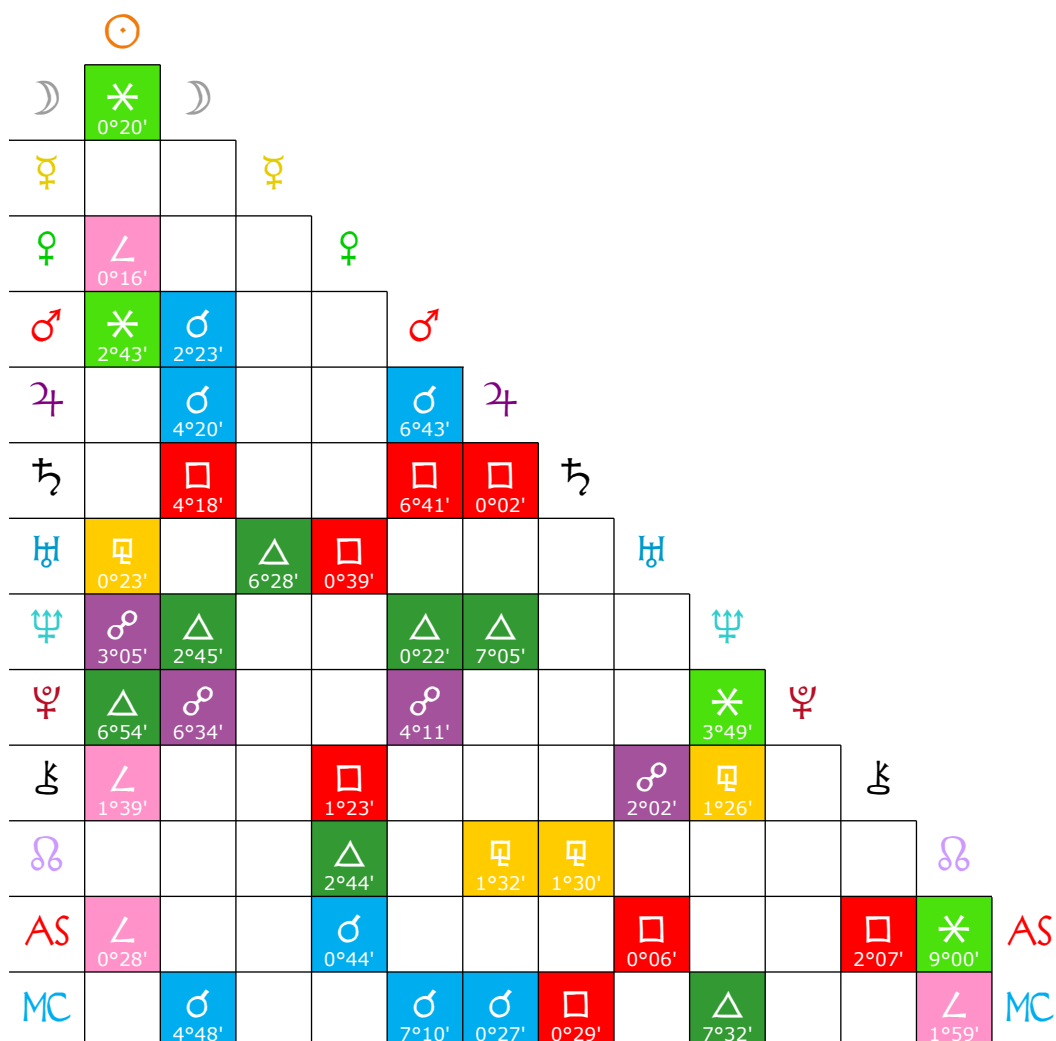

What Is Astrology?

The basic philosophy behind Astrology is the idea that we live in a holistic universe, that there is a deep interrelationship between the whole and its parts, and that anything, be it an event, a group, or an individual that is born at a particular point in time and space in a sense embodies the whole universe focused at that point.

Obviously it is impossible to determine the state of the whole universe from a particular point in time and space, so in Astrology we take the Solar system as the greater whole and regard the patterns formed by the Sun, Moon and planets as seen from a particular time and place on earth as a reflection of the forces acting at that time and place.

In natal astrology, astrology applied to individual human beings, the Sun, Moon and planets symbolise basic human needs, desires or urges which we all possess. It is the ever changing interrelationship between these basic functions or archetypes, and their relationship to the horizon at the time of birth, that are used to symbolise the personality structure of a human being.

Your Life Destiny Report details the following:

Elements

Each of the twelve signs is assigned to one of the four Elements: Earth, Air, Fire and Water. Each planet together with the Ascendant and Midheaven according to its sign therefore has an elemental quality.

Modality

Each of the twelve signs is assigned to one of three Modalities: Cardinal, Mutable and Fixed. Each planet together with the Ascendant and Midheaven according to its sign therefore has a specific quality or mode of operation.

The Planets

The Sun, Moon and the planets: - Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune and Pluto, represent specific functions, drives, or urges within the total personality. Just as in the body the various organs; heart, kidneys, liver etc. perform their own specific functions yet operate as part of a total system; so the planets can be regarded as symbolising the 'organs' of your total personality.

The Outer Planets

The planets beyond Saturn: - Uranus, Neptune and Pluto, move through the signs so slowly that the sign positions of these planets refer more to the generation of which we are a part, rather than individual characteristics.

It is the house position that shows where we will meet with the principles expressed by these planets in our lives. The aspects of these planets to the personal planets show how we get on with the principles they represent.

These trans-Saturnian planets cannot be seen without the aid of a telescope. Therefore they represent powerful forces that are beyond conscious control. These planets connect us with forces and levels of reality beyond our experience as individual human beings. They do this by breaking down the boundaries of the ego (symbolised by Saturn), to allow the inflow of higher ideals and goals into our ego-centred minds. This can often mean the total disruption or destruction of the outer and inner structures of our lives in order to make this possible.

Aspects

A conjunction is where two planets are at the same place, and their energies are merged together. Trines (when two planets are 120 degrees apart), and sextiles (60 degrees), between two planets indicate an easy flow of energy between the functions involved, they therefore show aspects of your personality that work harmoniously together indicating inherent abilities or talents.

Squares (when two planets are 90 degrees apart) and oppositions (when two planets are 180 degrees apart) show that there is some stress or tension between the two functions involved. Squares and oppositions between planets therefore indicate inner conflicts and tensions (conscious or unconscious) that throughout your life you will be forced to recognise and express in a positive way.

If you are not conscious of these inner conflicts, they will be confronted through seemingly 'fated' external events or in relationships with others, particularly when the planets involved are activated by transits (detailed in your forecast).

A tolerance or "orb" of about 8 degrees is allowed either side of the exact aspect, but the wider the orb, the weaker the influence. To the right of each pair of 'aspect' symbols is a group of five stars ★☆☆☆☆, the more dark stars there are the more important the connection.

There are also two sets of minor aspects. They have a smaller orb of influence, and their effects are not so noticeable. These include the semi-sextiles (when two planets are 30 degrees apart) and the quinquax (when they are 150 degrees apart). These minor aspects indicate energy patterns that are not well integrated into the individual's character. They exist, and of course, must be accommodated somehow.

The other series includes the semi-square (when two planets are 45 degrees apart) the sesquiquadrate (when two planets are 135 degrees apart). These minor aspects are quite similar to the square, only not quite as potent. They represent energy patterns that must be acted upon by the individual and, when properly used and understood, can bring about benefits in self-understanding.

This is not to say that trines and sextiles are "good" and squares and oppositions are "bad".

A chart dominated by flowing aspects may indicate someone for whom everything comes too easily, they will therefore lack any real motivation and may not achieve much during their life.

A chart with many stressful aspects, on the other hand, may indicate someone who driven by his or her own inner conflicts, can achieve something of real worth in their lives. The stressful aspects are just as necessary to us as the flowing aspects, and most of us are a fairly even balance of both.

The activity of each planet is further modified by the sign in which it is placed, the effects of these modifications in your particular case will be described in the chart analysis.

When astrologers cast horoscopes, it is important that the precise time of birth be used because it helps to determine the correct orientation of the houses of the chart. The position of the planets within the twelve houses, indicate which of these twelve areas of life concerns are most important for you.

Should a house have no planets, this does not mean that the affairs of the house are not important. It merely means that those affairs are probably well integrated and are not therefore major issues for you. But when a house has a planet or several planets, it indicates that the issues of the house are more significant.

The Signs

During the course of a year the Sun, as seen from the earth, appears to move in a circle against the background of the stars, this circle is known as the ecliptic. The axis of the earth's rotation is inclined at an angle to the plane of the ecliptic, so, if the earth's equator is imagined to be extended into space, it cuts the plane of the ecliptic at two points known as the equinoxes.

One of these points, the vernal or spring equinox, is taken to be the beginning of the circle and is known, both in Astronomy and Astrology, as the first point of Aries. Astrologers then divide the ecliptic into twelve sections of 30 degrees each thus generating the twelve signs. The autumn equinox is directly opposite the first point of Aries and is the beginning of the sign of Libra. When the Sun is at these points, days and nights are of equal length.

During the summer months the Sun appears to rise higher and higher in the sky, reaching its highest point at midsummer or the summer solstice, the beginning of the sign of Cancer. This is the time of the longest day and shortest night. Similarly, it reaches its lowest point in the sky in midwinter or the winter solstice, the beginning of the sign of Capricorn. This is the time of the shortest day and longest night.

The signs of zodiac therefore, has nothing to do with actual star constellations, but is based on the relationship between Sun and Earth.

The Houses (ignore when time of birth not known)

You will see that the chart is divided into twelve sections. These represent the division of the space surrounding you at birth. The sign on the first house "cusp" (the line that marks the beginning of the house) is the sign that was rising over the horizon at the time and place of your birth this is your rising sign, (or Ascendant). The sign on the seventh house cusp is the sign that was setting at the time of your birth, the line between the first and 7th house cusps therefore represents the horizon.

Planets in the upper hemisphere were therefore above the horizon at the time of birth, and planets in the lower hemisphere were below the horizon; planets in the left hemisphere (left of the line joining the 0th and 4th house cusps) were rising in the east and planets in the right hemisphere were setting in the west.

Each house represents a specific area of life experience. The positions of the planets in these houses therefore show in what areas of experience the effects of these planets will be most noticeable. The Ascendant is an important point and has its own particular meaning.

The Birth Chart

The birth chart is a symbolic map of the solar system as seen from the earth at the time and place of birth. The chart is comprised of three basic factors.

(1) The aspects (angles) formed between the Sun, Moon and planets, as seen from the earth. These are indicated by the lines on a birth chart.

(2) Each planet is located in a particular sign of the zodiac. The symbols for each sign are placed around the edge of the chart, Aries, Taurus, Gemini, Cancer, Leo, Virgo, Libra, Scorpio, Sagittarius, Capricorn, Aquarius, and Pisces.

(3) Each planet is also located in a particular house in the chart. These are indicated by the twelve sections of a birth chart.

Your birth chart is therefore a unique blueprint of your personality, every one is different. When you are born, the birth chart represents a set of potentials, it describes the 'form' of your personality and the contents must be added through the experiences of life.

Life Destiny Interpretation

Your birth chart shows the exact positions of the planets at your time of birth. It also tells you the sign of the Zodiac that was rising at your time of birth, known as your 'ascendant'. How the planetary positions of your birth chart relate to each other are interpreted on the following pages outlining your potential development. The interpretation begins with Elements and Modalities of your horoscope.

Element Emphasis

Fire Element strong - Angelina's energy level

An original self-starter, you do not need any external stimuli to get you motivated. You do not like inactivity and will make every effort to change stagnant situations if they exist. Courageous, full of life and quite dramatic, you can be a successful leader and the first in line to explore uncharted territory. However, your tendency to act first and think later can lead others to selfishness. Learn to be more aware of other people's feelings.

Earth Element weak - Angelina's dependability

You find it difficult to handle 'the matter-of-fact', daily detail of living. There is an inclination to be either confused most of the time or to be always making plans or schemes that you cannot complete. The dread of the responsibility of adulthood causes you to do things that others judge as juvenile or foolish. If you want to avoid that judgment, try to learn to establish a stricter daily routine for yourself.

Modality Emphasis

Cardinal Modality strong - Angelina's capabilities

Your greatest strength is your ability to start things going, relationships, projects, etc. You do not care whether something has been done before, if it interests you, you will give it a try. You are innovative and content in positions of leadership, but more likely to be gloomy and dejected in any subordinate role. Once projects are under way, however, you can lose interest in them. It would be ideal if you had someone to go after you and clear up the chaos you can leave in your wake.

Fixed Modality weak - Angelina's consistency

You tend to find it very difficult to stick to anything once it is begun, whether it is a job, a diet or a relationship. Your life must always be filled with variety and change in a continuous kaleidoscopic way or you get discouraged. Unless you learn to build some stability into your life, others will tend to think that you can never carry anything through to its logical conclusion.

The Ascendant

The Ascendant is the sign that was rising over the horizon at the time of birth. More than any other chart factor, the sign of the Ascendant, to be accurate, is dependant on both time (it changes by 15 degrees every hour) and place of birth (someone born at the same time on the opposite side of the world will have the opposite sign on the Ascendant or 'rising'). As such, it is the sign that brings us into physical incarnation, and the planet that rules that sign is said to be the ruler of the chart, or our planetary ruler for this lifetime. Hence the sign and house position of the Ascendant's ruler are of particular importance. The ascending sign shows the way in which we approach life and the world in general. It can be related to what some psychologists call the persona, the mask we place between our inner selves and the world. As such it shows the way in which, we are perceived by others, at least their first impressions of us. The Ascendant represents the manner in which we must express ourselves in order to feel secure, and also the filter through which we perceive life and its challenges. It is the cusp of the first house, the house associated with our personal identity and self expression and represents the kind of energy and types of activities that we need to enliven us physically.

Cancer Ascendant

The Cardinal Water sign of Cancer was rising at the time of your birth, indicating that you are sensitive and reserved in your approach to others, although you may have learned at an early age to protect your sensitivity behind the hard outer shell of the crab. You have a naturally caring and sympathetic nature, and you like to take care of those who are close to you, you have an instinctive understanding of their emotional needs. This same emotional sensitivity makes you vulnerable, however, since not everybody has the same consideration for your feelings as you have for theirs. You will tend to hide any hurt or emotional pain behind a hard exterior, and to approach situations indirectly rather than risk a direct confrontation. You may have a tendency to cling to any hurt or slight, whether real or imagined, and you will need to learn to accept your sensitive emotional nature and channel it in some positive direction.

Cancer is ruled by the Moon, as the ruler of your ascendant this planet is of particular importance in your chart.

Alternative Rising Sign?

Your Ascendant falls near the cusp of the following Sign. So if your birth time is possibly up to an hour or so later than what you have given it as, you could have a Leo Ascendant.

Leo Ascendant

With the Fixed Fire sign Leo rising at your time of birth you aim to make an impression on everyone you meet. You have a need to be known as a creative and self-motivated person, and to develop a sense of your own power and worth. You need to be active in some kind of creative or self-expressive pursuit in order to feel enlivened, but your pride may often prevent you from admitting your mistakes to anyone but yourself, or from changing a course of action even when it becomes plain that you are on the wrong track, you do not like to be proved wrong. You can be warm and generous, not slow to give to those who need your help, but there may be a tendency to expect something in return, you will be happier and more content with yourself when you can learn to give without expecting to receive.

The ruler of Leo is the Sun, as the ruler of your ascendant, this planet is of particular importance in your chart.

Ascendant Semisquare Sun

The Semisquare between your Ascendant and Sun indicates some conflict between the way you express yourself, and your inner sense of self identity. There may be a feeling of blocked energy, and a sense of frustration that you do not come across to others as you really are. This sense of frustration probably comes from your experience of your parents; one or both of them may have prevented you from being yourself and expressing yourself in the way that you wanted. You can release this energy through the disciplined pursuit of some ambition or path, so that through your achievements you can confidently feel that you did it yourself, and in your own way.

Ascendant Conjoint Venus

The Conjunction between Venus and your Ascendant indicates that you are able to express yourself with charm and diplomacy. You are probably well spoken, and able to impress others with your refined tastes and social graces. You are always willing to compromise where necessary, but necessary usually means whether it is to your advantage, if you feel that a compromise leaves you the loser, or you do not get what you want, you can become petulant and moody. Beneath the polished veneer there is a strong element of self-interest, you often use your charms to further your own interests, or to cultivate social contacts that will benefit you in some way.

Ascendant Square Uranus

The Square between Uranus and your Ascendant indicates that you have a restless and erratic temperament. Possibly your experiences as a child have left you feeling afraid to get too close or too dependent on others, leading to problems in your domestic and/or professional life later on. You insist on going your own way and doing your own thing, but your demands for complete freedom from duty and responsibility will create inevitable conflicts in your relationships. If you feel that you are being tied down, in spite of all your efforts to avoid such a situation, you will break away from the restricting influence, often in ways that will surprise or even shock others, in fact you probably gain some enjoyment from shocking people.

In your desire to remain a "free spirit" you will show little consideration for the feelings and needs of other people, behaving in ways that can generate a lot of enmity towards you. You will probably have to learn the hard way that if you are not around for others when they need you most, you cannot expect them to be around when you need them.



The Sun

In the solar system the Sun is the focal point around which all the other planets revolve, bound by its gravitational force. Similarly, in the birth chart the Sun represents the "centre" of our personality, or the core of our being, around which all the other psychological drives and needs, symbolised by the planets, revolve.

Just as, in the solar system, the Sun is the source of light and life generating energy, so the Sun represents the source of consciousness and life within us all. It is our will to be and our sense of individuality. The birth chart, however, represents the solar system as seen from the earth, not the Sun. Most of us are not centred in our Sun, but in our earthbound, or sense-bound ego. For most of us then, the Sun represents our 'Higher Self' or Spirit. It is the immortal spark of the universal spirit which is uniquely ourselves, as opposed to our transient and mortal ego centred personality. The Sun is therefore what we are striving to become.

The sign position of and aspects to the Sun, as seen from the earth, show how this radiant inner self works through the medium of our ego centred personality. It is the fundamental tone of our being, and as such is the most important placement in the chart.



Sun in Gemini

With the Sun in the mutable air sign of Gemini, you are basically attuned to the level of the mind (symbolised by air). There is restlessness and a need for variety. You have a basic urge to extend yourself through a variety of different contacts and relationships. You are usually on the go, and have a natural ability to do two or more things at once. You have a need for constant intellectual stimulation, and welcome the opportunity to express your opinions, which you can do very well on a number of different subjects. The versatility and adaptability of the Sun in Gemini, if taken to extremes, can lead to a superficial knowledge of many subjects, inconsistency, and the tendency to change your tack in midcourse; then back again, then back. You will need to develop the will power to see a particular course of action through to its conclusion.

11th House

The 11th House is naturally associated with the sign of Aquarius and its ruler Uranus.

Having established a career, public position or our social standing in the 10th, in the 11th House we look to the future and the part we can play as members of various groups or societies. The 11th House therefore represents our hopes and wishes, friends and groups. It is in this area of experience that we seek to act as part of a group that is expressing some greater social need or goal. This house in the chart can indicate how we act in group situations and the kinds of groups to which we are attracted.



Sun in 11th House

With the Sun in the 11th house you may find you need a large circle of friends and acquaintances. This need can be extended to various groups and associations that are trying to achieve some sort of social change. Through such groups you will be able to express yourself openly and gain a sense of purpose and direction. However, you will need to suppress the desire to always be the leader of such groups as you may not always be the right person for the job.



Sun Sextile Moon

With the Sun and the Moon in a Sextile aspect, you have learned from the experiences of your past, and these experiences serve as a valuable foundation for the present and future. You have the inner confidence and courage to face life's challenges.

Your relationship with your parents as a child would have probably been with major conflicts, and this has carried into adulthood as you generally get on with your parents, and they are always there to lend a helping hand when you need it. Even if their own relationship had problems, this probably would not have had any long term effects on your own relationship with either of them.



Sun Semisquare Venus

With the Semisquare aspect between the Sun and Venus you are not sure whether you are truly attractive or not, and are not reassured by those who are close to you. Remember that people are attracted to you because of what you are. They accept you as you are, and so should you.



Sun Sextile Mars

The Sextile between the Sun and Mars indicates that you have tremendous energy and are eager to get ahead in life. You have the courage of your convictions and will not rest until you achieve your goals.

You can be forceful and direct in expressing your ideas. If you feel you are winning an argument you will hammer the point home, but you are also willing to admit that you are not always right. Indeed, if you can see that you are wrong, you will admit defeat gracefully.



Sun Sesquiquadrate Uranus

The Sesquiquadrate between the Sun and Uranus makes you a very strong willed and independent. When younger, you will probably have been very rebellious, and even now others may regard you as an individualist with little or no regard for rules or authority. In fact at times you may deliberately set out to shock others just to prove that you won't be bound by any rules or restrictions.

You value your personal freedom very highly, and may even deliberately disrupt a stable situation if you feel it has become too restricting or confining. Your interests and goals may change suddenly several times throughout your life.

This aspect represents a challenge to be met, and channelled into positive directions. Always ready to help those in need, you often put your energetic nature to work for others, rather than yourself, and fight for the freedom and the needs of others who can't fight for themselves.



Sun Opposition Neptune

The Opposition between the Sun and Neptune indicates that at times you may have some difficulty separating fact from fiction. You are a dreamer with high ideals, but you may tend to look to others to make your dreams a reality, and if they fail to do so, you may feel confused and let down.

Rather than looking to other people to deal with life for you, you need to find your own sense of purpose and direction. Your biggest enemy is your own self-doubt which causes you to underestimate your own abilities, and perhaps turn down opportunities for growth that would have been of great benefit to you.



Sun Trine Pluto

With a Trine between the Sun and Pluto in your chart you will have a strong desire to make something of yourself, and the determination to succeed in whatever task you set yourself. You would like to bring order out of chaos, and to encourage and teach others to achieve their full potential. You will be admired by others for your courage and determination in fighting for what you believe to be right. They'll recognise that your arguments are based on a deep insight and a genuine desire to put things right.

You will also be aware that people's lives are, at times, guided by some higher purpose or power and that even difficult or painful experiences often lead to greater opportunities and personal fulfilment. As a result, you are generally able to weather your own personal crises with the knowledge that it will lead to greater self understanding, and bigger and better success.



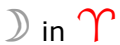
Moon

In the birth chart, the Moon is second in importance only to the Sun. Unlike the other planets the Moon orbits the earth, and seen from the earth is the same size as the Sun (hence the possibility of total eclipses). The Moon gives off no light of its own, however, but reflects and polarises the light of the Sun.

The Moon represents memories, feelings and instinctive responses that lie just below the level of consciousness. As the Moon orbits the earth, it generates the movements of the tides and governs other natural cycles, such as the menstrual cycle in women. The Moon therefore symbolises the ebb and flow of feeling and emotion (symbolised by water in Astrology), and the feminine principle in nature and in the individual.

The sign position of and aspects to the Moon show how we react instinctively, and what we need to feel comfortable and secure. As children the Moon is the Mother, or at least how we experienced our mother. As we grow older this extends to our relationships with women in general (particularly for men), and our instinctive or conditioned responses to the world in general; based on the often unconscious memories of this early nurturing experience (or lack of it).

When the time of birth is not known the exact position of the Moon may be different to that shown in your Midday birth chart. You can experiment with alternative birth times to see if the Moon's sign changes on the day you were born and read the different interpretations for each Moon sign.



Moon in Aries

With the Moon in the cardinal fire sign of Aries, you react instinctively to emotional stimuli through direct action. You have a tendency to leap before you look. You can be naturally courageous with the inner urge to get things done, or you can be impulsive and quick tempered, with a tendency to put your own feelings before those of others. You have an enthusiasm for life, and a naturally direct approach, but you need to consciously develop patience. Other chart factors may show you to be patient and understanding, but if you are caught unexpectedly, or your feelings are hurt, you can surprise yourself and others with the strength of your anger and repressed selfishness.

9th House

The 9th House is naturally associated with the sign of Sagittarius and its ruler Jupiter.

After the often painful experiences in the 8th, in the 9th House we seek to understand the meaning of our experiences and our connections to the greater whole. This House represents our search for meaning through philosophy and religion. In this area of life we also seek to expand our knowledge and awareness through travel and higher education. Hence this House is also connected with all forms of higher education, travel to foreign lands, the law, religion and the use of the higher or more intuitive mental faculties.



Moon in 9th House

The 9th House is the area of your chart that is connected with philosophy, religion, travel and higher education. With the Moon in this House you may find emotional security from some belief system. This may be inherited from your family background, but you have the ability to adapt your philosophy to changing influences and conditions.

Travel may be linked with your emotional life, and you may live abroad for a time. There is also an attraction to women of a foreign culture, or who can expand or broaden your horizons in some way.



Moon Conjunct Mars

A Conjunction between the Moon and Mars indicates a high degree of emotional sensitivity. You are genuinely hurt by criticism, even when it is not meant to be taken too seriously. There will be times when you will find it difficult to forgive people who have hurt you in the past. Even if you want to and can understand their reasons, the memory of your pain keeps coming back to haunt you, giving rise to feelings of frustration and anger.

Your emotions and enthusiasm are closely linked. When you are feeling good you can work tirelessly toward an objective, but when you are feeling down your motivation evaporates and you feel unable to do anything, even daily chores seem a bind.



Moon Conjunct Jupiter

With the Moon Conjunct Jupiter you are both generous and sympathetic towards others, with a genuine concern for those in need. Any personal ambitions you may have will be directed by a need to contribute something positive which benefit others as well as yourself. You learn something positive from all your experiences, and this optimism and faith helps life to work in your favour, with things generally working out well for you.



Moon Square Saturn

With the Square between the Moon and Saturn, you may occasionally have a tendency to place duty and responsibility before your emotional needs. It may be that in your childhood not enough attention was given to your emotional needs, leaving you feeling that they are unimportant, or that they should be sacrificed to more practical concerns.

Perhaps you experienced your parents as being very judgmental or detached, or perhaps one or both of them was not there at all. As you grow older you will learn to make your own judgements on yourself, and not take the opinions of others too much to heart. It is therefore important that you find some way of expressing yourself emotionally, and learn to listen to your heart as well as your head.



Moon Trine Neptune

The Trine between the Moon and Neptune stimulates your imagination and emotions. Both the Moon and Neptune being watery, receptive planets, you can be acutely aware of the needs and feelings of others, being able to pick up on the atmosphere around you.

However, perhaps at times you are too sensitive, so that whilst you are open to the needs of others, you may not always be too sure about your own needs and feelings. This makes you vulnerable and liable to be taken advantage of, perhaps without you even realising it.



Moon Opposition Pluto

The Opposition between the Moon and Pluto produces deep feelings that may occasionally be difficult to get to grips with or to understand. Your personal life may often be the scene for intense emotional power battles in which one or both of you attempts to manipulate the other through feelings of guilt, jealousy and possessiveness. The source of these confrontations probably lies in your past. You will need to understand that source before you can effectively deal with the problems at hand.

With this aspect you will go through changes throughout your life that will force you to look within yourself to deal with problems and answer important questions, but you will always emerge from these periods a stronger person than you were before



Mercury

Mercury is the closest planet to the Sun. Along with Venus it is one of the inferior planets, that is, its orbit lies within the earth's orbit.

In mythology, Mercury is the messenger of the gods. In the birth chart, Mercury represents the urge to communicate with and exchange information with others. In the mind, it represents our rational thought processes, or the ability to analyse and reach logical conclusions. In the body, it is the nervous system, which co-ordinates and unifies all the different bodily functions into an organised whole. Mercury can be said to represent electricity in the form of information. Mercury therefore rules all forms of communication and exchange of information, and the ability to organise facts into a consistent view of the world.

The sign position of and aspects to Mercury in the chart show how one thinks and communicates, that is, the way in which our thoughts are expressed, and the way in which we receive such information from the world around us.



Mercury in Gemini

Mercury, the planet of communication, is in the mutable air sign of Gemini in your chart, indicating that you have a lively and enquiring mind. Your interests are varied, and you may find it difficult to concentrate on one thing for too long, other ideas and possibilities are always crowding into your mind. This can make your thinking rather scattered and you may find it difficult to make up your mind on anything, then change it when you do. On the other hand, you are eager and able to learn a variety of different subjects, and to see connections that you may miss through a narrower and more particular form of knowledge. You will have a great need to communicate your insights and knowledge to others.



Mercury in 11th House

Mercury in the 11th House of your chart indicates an intelligent, progressive mind. You may also become involved in various group activities, where you can meet people who will help you acquire the skills you need to pursue your goals in life. Indeed, it is generally through these group situations that you can most easily express yourself and put across your ideas and opinions.

This positioning of Mercury in the 11th House is good for teachers and lecturers, or any field that involves communication and the media. You have many original and inventive ideas, which you need to get across to as wide an audience as possible. Friends will often inspire you with their energy, helping you to clarify your thoughts and make the most of your ideas.

However, there may be issues around brothers and sisters which will have to be faced and dealt with at some time. Friends will also be important here, either as part of the issue, or instrumental in helping to resolve them.



Mercury Trine Uranus

The effect of the planet Uranus is often likened to electrical energy with the Trine aspect to Mercury your nervous system and intellect is stimulated and electrified, but in a way that is creative rather than difficult. Your mind works so fast that you may consider other peoples thinking slow by comparison, you can analyse a problem and see instantly connections and possibilities, and make logical leaps, hat others may labour over for a long time. When you reach a conclusion it seems as if the answer just came intuitively, when in fact it was the result of extremely fast analysis.

You have an original and inventive mind open to new ideas and new ways of thinking, you seek knowledge avidly for the freedom and understanding you gain from it, rather than for any qualifications you may gain. Forward looking and revolutionary you have creative solutions to many of the world's problems, and have little patience for traditional and conventional solutions or ways of thinking, you would certainly not regard 'Victorian values' as a solution to present day problems.



Venus

Venus, like Mercury, lies within the orbit of the earth. If Mercury can be likened to electricity in the form of information, then Venus can be likened to the magnetic field generated by the electric current. One of the meanings of Venus is therefore "personal magnetism".

In mythology Venus is the goddess of love. In the birth chart, Venus represents the social and love urge, and the need for harmony and exchange of feelings and affection with others. Venus is our need to form relationships and our power to attract such relationships. It is also our sense of values, based on what attracts or repels us.

The sign position of any aspect to Venus shows how we express these needs to others and the kind of response we need in order to feel in harmony. If Venus is adversely placed these responses may not always be what we consciously desire but are often necessary in order to force us to recognise some unexpressed part of ourselves.

Venus in Cancer

Venus in the cardinal Water sign of Cancer indicates that in your relationships, you seek a deep sense of emotional sharing with another person. The fear of being hurt will cause you to hide behind an outer shell of apparent coolness until you feel secure enough to express your true feelings, when you do, however, you are sensitive and caring but may overdo it and emotionally smother the other person. Your approach to matters of love, are deeply linked to your need for a home and security. This is not to say that this is all that you are looking for; it is just that you will find it difficult to relate emotionally to another person unless these needs are satisfied.

12th House

The 12th House is naturally associated with the sign of Pisces and its ruler Neptune.

After becoming part of a larger group structure in the 11th, in the 12th House we experience the dissolution of our separate individual ego. This House represents the area of experience where we feel that we are influenced by forces and powers that are beyond our control. In this House we surrender our individual wills to the service of a higher power or ideal, or direct our energies toward greater self realisation and spiritual goals.

On a more mundane level, this House is associated with large institutions such as hospitals and prisons, where many people end up if the self-surrender described above is overdone, or made to the wrong ideals. Hence this House is also known as the House of self-undoing.

Venus in 12th House

With Venus in the 12th House of your chart there may be occasional confusion surrounding your love life as at times you may not fully understand your own needs in a relationship.

Venus Square Uranus

Venus, the planet of relationships is in a Square aspect to the more independent planet Uranus. At times you may therefore experience some difficulty, and sudden changes or breaks in your relationships. If people try to get too close too quickly, you will rapidly back off.

You also probably have little regard for traditional forms of marriage since this would considerably reduce your freedom to do what you want, a freedom you do not easily relinquish. Any form of jealousy and possessiveness particularly horrifies you.

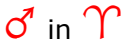
Even if you are involved in a serious relationship, or married, you will still demand a great deal of freedom and independence for yourself. You may try to suppress these needs for a while out of respect for the other person's feelings or wishes, but if you do so for too long, the tensions will build up until your need for freedom erupts to the surface.



Mars

Mars is the first planet in the series out from the Sun that is outside the orbit of the earth. As the first superior planet, Mars represents energy directed outward from the self into the world. It is the energy to initiate action and the ability to meet challenges and overcome obstacles. In mythology, Mars is the god of war. In the birth chart, Mars is the self assertive and aggressive urge, the sex drive and the need to achieve our desires. Positively, Mars is expressed as courage, initiative, and the will-power to pursue our goals. Negatively expressed, Mars is impatience, violence and the use of force or threats.

The sign position of and aspects to Mars in the chart show how we assert ourselves and express our desires. Mars is traditionally a masculine planet, and therefore represents the expression of the male ego. In a woman's chart, the energy of Mars is often repressed by social and family conditioning, and indicates how she will experience the male ego through the men around her, whether positively or negatively expressed. It is, however, becoming increasingly possible for women to break away from traditional passive roles, and express their own Martian drives, but this is often not completely successful until after the age of about 30.



Mars in Aries

Mars, the planet of drive and aggression, is in the cardinal fire sign of Aries, the sign that it rules. This strongly accentuates both the positive and negative qualities of Mars. You will be direct and forceful, with a strong self assertive and competitive urge. There is a strong need for independence, but it might be a type of independence based on a lack of thought for others. Aggressiveness, impulsiveness and a tendency to over-react to real or imagined slights are qualities that need to be controlled. You will be very direct when it comes to getting what you want, with little beating about the bush, but you will have to control the urge to leap before you look.



Mars in 9th House

With Mars in the 9th House of your chart, you will put a great deal of energy into travel, study, possibly of a philosophical nature, and fighting for the rights of others. You could therefore achieve success as a teacher, lawyer or writer.



Mars Conjoint Jupiter

With Mars and Jupiter in Conjunction you have a driving ambition to achieve something worthwhile with your life. When challenged, you don't admit defeat easily, always eager to fight back. You can therefore be a considerable force to be reckoned with!

This aspect can compensate for other, more self-effacing, aspects in your birth chart, giving you the optimism and faith that you will eventually get what you want if you try hard enough.

However, at times, you will need to be careful to evaluate just what is possible, and not get caught up in too many unrealistic plans, or promise more than you can deliver. If you can do this, then your life can become an adventure in which you meet challenges with enthusiasm and the inner certainty that you will succeed.

Mars Square Saturn

The Square between Mars and Saturn indicates that occasionally you may have some difficulty in asserting yourself and getting what you want. You can alternate between being aggressive and submissive. At times you may refuse to assert yourself, or to stand up for yourself even when it is necessary, but at other times, you can suddenly release anger, surprising others with the ferocity of your attack. Energies must therefore be channelled toward planned objectives. If you don't do this, then the unused, frustrated energies can become dammed up, and the resulting rise in inner pressure experienced as anger.

Mars Trine Neptune

With your ability to see clearly how present circumstances are the result of past actions, you are able to help others with the insight you have gained from your own experiences.

Mars Opposition Pluto

The Opposition between Mars and Pluto gives tremendous reserves of raw power that need to be directed into creative rather than negative uses. Most probably, through the experiences of difficult relationships you will learn to cope with the problems that arise in your life with great depth and insight, leading to a better understanding of yourself and those around you.

Jupiter

The planets up to and including Mars have been concerned with the establishment of ourselves as individuals, and with the satisfaction of our own needs and desires. The planets beyond Mars connect us with a larger order.

As the largest planet in the solar system, Jupiter represents expansion and growth. It is the urge to grow beyond our individual limitations and the need to feel part of a larger order, whether this be a particular religion, philosophy or social system. Jupiter, the king of the gods, traditionally bestows faith, optimism and the ability to expand and prosper. It is the planet that promotes personal growth, gives us confidence in ourselves and trust in a higher power or greater plan. Negatively, Jupiter can manifest as overconfidence, irresponsibility and the tendency to over-extend ourselves or promise too much.

The sign position of and aspects to Jupiter in the chart show what kinds of experiences and types of activity create an inner faith and optimism, and the sense of being connected to the larger scheme of things.

Jupiter in Aries

The planet Jupiter represents the principle of expansion and growth, it is the optimistic urge to broaden our horizons both mentally and materially. In the cardinal fire sign of Aries you will need to maintain a high level of enterprise, coupled with a sense of self esteem, in order to make the most of opportunities that may come your way. This will be easy enough when things are going well, at such times you will feel confident and determined, even over confident and over zealous, but when things go wrong your confidence may crash and your determination collapse, or you will react with anger. You need to feel that you play a part in the greater scheme of things to maintain your self confidence and sense of identity.

You are independent and you need the freedom to pursue your own goals. You feel that you are establishing your own identity when you are chasing distant horizons, and you do not like to be obstructed on the journey.

Jupiter in 9th House

Jupiter is in the 9th House of your chart, the area of experience connected with travel and higher education, religion and philosophy. It is through these activities that you can best grow beyond your present mental and physical limitations and find faith and meaning in life.

Indeed, this is a good placing for long distance travel, but this will be most beneficial if undertaken as a learning experience, for the purpose of gaining greater understanding and knowledge. In these matters foreign people should be of great benefit to you.

Jupiter Trine Neptune

The Trine aspect between Jupiter and Neptune indicates that sometimes you can be something of an idealist. You feel intuitively that there is more to life than meets the eye, and that spiritual or unseen forces are at work to help shape our destiny, and you also feel the need to understand the nature of these forces.

You have an easy-going nature, but if you follow your natural inclination to go with the crowd you could often find yourself in circumstances that you would rather have avoided. Seeing the best in everybody leaves you open to being deceived and let down, but you are usually able to pick yourself up again, and you find that a helping hand is usually available when you need it most.

Saturn

Saturn is the last planet in the solar system that can be seen with the naked eye from the earth. As such, together with the fact that it is bounded by a series of rings, Saturn represents the boundaries of the individual.

After the limitless expansion of Jupiter, Saturn in the birth chart represents boundaries and limitations. It is the principle of structure and form. In the body, it is the skeleton, which gives the body its structure, and the skin, which is the boundary to the outside world. In the mind, it is the structure of our ego and our sense of self which we seek to preserve from the impact of changes from within and from the outside world. Saturn gives us the ability to endure setbacks and work with discipline and patience toward well defined aims. It is the need for social approval through some kind of tangible achievement. Whereas Jupiter brings rewards and opportunities through what we might call good luck, Saturn brings rewards and opportunities through hard work, limitation and self discipline.

The sign position of and aspects to Saturn show how we seek to establish ourselves as individuals and find our place in the social system of which we are a part. Any form or structure, however, when placed in the light of the Sun tends to cast a shadow. The position of Saturn in the chart therefore, shows where we find our "shadow". It is here that we meet with our greatest sense of inadequacy, lack of faith and inhibitions. Saturn shows where we are most fearful, and hence most rigid; but if these fears can be met and overcome it is the source of our greatest strength and a solid foundation from which to meet the world.

Saturn in Cancer

Saturn in the cardinal water sign of Cancer, indicates a need to deal with blocked or repressed feelings and emotions concerning your home life or early experiences. You may find it difficult to express your feelings openly, as a result of being inhibited when you were young. Perhaps one of your parents did not respond as you would have liked, placing too much emphasis on duty and responsibility and not providing for your need for nurturing and emotional support. Others may find you to be somewhat reserved and lacking real emotion, but this is rarely truly the case. Your feelings run deeper than most, but you do not reveal them until you are sure that they will not be rejected or ridiculed.

There may be an over-emphasis on the need to acquire property, believing that this will provide the stability and security that you crave. You may have to go through several bad experiences in this area before you learn that such security can only come from within yourself. When you can do this, you will have an unshakeable grounding from which you can go out to meet the world.

Saturn in 12th House

Saturn in the 12th House of your chart shows that you may occasionally be suspicious of other people's motives. At times you will need to completely withdraw from others in order to realign mind, body and soul, but people who do not really understand you may feel that they are being personally rejected. You may find it difficult to make a commitment to anyone, or anything, out of a fear of losing your own individuality. If you can find the courage for some honest self-examination, and get to the root of what is really bothering you, you will find or rediscover, the courage of your convictions.



Uranus

Uranus is the first of the trans-Saturnian planets. It cannot be seen with the naked eye and was discovered in 1781 during the period of the American and French revolutions. Its discovery was made possible by the invention of the telescope, a development that has led to radical changes in our knowledge of the universe and our place in it.

In the birth chart then, Uranus represents the force for revolutionary change, the breaking from tradition, and inventiveness and experimentation. As one of the three planets that cannot be seen with the unaided eye, Uranus represents a force over which we have little or no conscious control. On an individual level, Uranus indicates our degree of independence and demand for personal freedom. If well placed it gives us originality and an ability to attune to truth that goes beyond the logic of Mercury. If we refuse to express the energy of Uranus within us, preferring to cling to the traditions and limitations of Saturn, then Uranus may manifest as disruptions and sudden changes in our immediate environment, sometimes disrupting our lives completely and forcing us to make needed changes. If the energy of Uranus is expressed negatively, it can lead to wilfulness, impatience and needless rebellion, the rebel without a cause.

The position of Uranus in the chart shows where we most feel the need for freedom and independence and the need to experiment with new ideas and ways of living. Conversely, it is the area where we can cause the most disruption and needless change.



Uranus in Libra

You attract unusual friends and unconventional romance but will always demand freedom and space to pursue your own goals and ambitions. So do think twice before rushing headlong into making a long term commitment or the relationship could end in divorce or separation. Nevertheless, your ability to communicate new ideas to others can help open their minds to possibilities and experiences never experienced before.

4th House

The 4th House is naturally associated with the sign of Cancer and its ruling planet, the Moon.

In the 3rd House we are concerned with communicating with our immediate environment, this leads, in the 4th, to the need to establish a private domain to which we can retreat from the world.

The 4th House represents our roots, both psychological and material. In the psychological sense it is our early family and cultural conditioning, which gives us a sense of belonging, and produces deep inner feelings and habit patterns. The 4th House together with the opposite House, the 10th, is connected with our experience of our parents. In the material sense it is our own home, from which we go out to meet the world and to which we can retreat to rest and recuperate. As well as representing our early home environment, this House is also connected with the conditions surrounding us during the second half of life.



Uranus in 4th House

Uranus in the 4th House signifies difficult circumstances surrounding your home life. There may be many disruptions in this area, making it difficult to put down roots or feel secure. This may stem from your early experiences with your parents, one or both of them may have been rebellious, unstable or unpredictable, you never knew when or whether they were going to be there. On the other hand, your parents may have been involved in some activity that brought you into contact with diverse cultures and belief systems. As a result of these experiences, you attract the same sort of energy into your own home and private life. No matter how hard you try to settle down, circumstances or other people seem to do their best to disrupt your security. Perhaps the way to deal with this is not to seek security along conventional lines, security comes with the freedom to be yourself and allow others to do the same.

You need to understand your cultural origins and how you can contribute to the process of change and evolution on a more collective level.



Neptune

After Uranus comes Neptune, the god of the sea. Whereas Uranus is the urge for individual freedom and independence, Neptune is the urge to escape from our normal sense-bound state of consciousness, and experience our unity with a different level of reality.

In the birth chart, Neptune represents our higher ideals and our ability to attune to realities that lie beyond those perceived by the senses. It is the realm of dreams and imagination and our sense of being part of a whole which is greater than ourselves, the awareness of a spiritual dimension to existence. Neptune represents the urge to transcend our normal state of consciousness through meditation and mystical experience, music, dreams and flights of the imagination, or through drugs (including alcohol) which afford us a temporary escape from the mundane grind of living. Neptune can be expressed as high ideals, altruism and spiritual values, or as self destructive escapism and evasion of responsibilities. For most of us it is a mixture of both.

The position of Neptune in the chart shows where and how we seek to express these needs, and in what areas of our lives we tend to seek an often impossible ideal.



Neptune in Sagittarius

Born between 1970-1984 you are part of a generation that will that will develop a need for higher religious, mystical and spiritual values. Travel will attract you as will the exchange of ideas and religions with other countries.

5th House

The 5th House is naturally associated with the sign Leo and its ruler the Sun.

In the 4th House we establish our material and psychological roots, in the 5th we seek to express our own creativity. Creativity can be expressed through children as extensions of our physical bodies, or through various art forms as extensions of our inner selves. This House is also associated with leisure activities, sports, gambling, love affairs etc. in fact all forms of recreation where we seek to express ourselves freely and without inhibition.



Neptune in 5th House

With Neptune in the 5th House of your chart you have a strong creative imagination and the ability to bring it into the open with dramatic flair through some form of artistic expression. Wherever Neptune is found in the chart, some form of sacrifice or confusion may be experienced. In this House you may sacrifice all for arts sake, or you may be forced to give up your creative and artistic aspirations to deal with more earthly and practical duties.

You are intensely idealistic in your romantic pursuits, willing to sacrifice all for love or being content to view through rose-tinted glasses and worship from afar. With children, also, there may be an element of sacrifice, perhaps you will feel that you have had to give up your own aspirations for the sake of your children, if this is the case there is a danger of attempting to live out your own ideals through them, rather than let them find themselves and learn by their own mistakes.



Neptune Sextile Pluto

This aspect between the two outermost planets first occurred in 1942 and will remain in effect for the next hundred years, although the sign positions of the planets will change, so everyone born during this time will have it in their charts. This contact will therefore affect everyone for the next hundred years and represents changes taking place in the world's collective psyche. The keynote of this entire period will be the complete transformation of our existing scientific, religious and political belief systems.



Pluto

Pluto is the outermost planet in the solar system and therefore the slowest moving. At certain times however, due to the high eccentricity of its orbit, it comes closer to the earth than Neptune. This was so from 1984 -1999. At that same time it passed through Scorpio, the sign that it rules. This was a very critical period in world history, since Pluto represents powerful forces of death and destruction or change and transformation, which were at their strongest. This could have lead to destruction through nuclear war or our pollution and exploitation of our planet or to the death of the current political and economical systems and the birth of new political and economic systems, together with a transformation in international relations as well as our relationship to our planet. When Pluto left Scorpio in 1999 all these issues were much altered.

In the individual birth chart, Pluto represents the urge for power and control either over ourselves or others. It is the need to penetrate beneath the surface of experience, to reveal hidden motivations and repressed desires. The position of Pluto in the chart indicates our capacity for self-regeneration or rebirth and our attitude towards beginnings and endings and birth and death, either actual or symbolic. Pluto can be expressed as the acceptance of our need for complete transformation in some area of our life, and the courage to face our deepest compulsions and hang-ups. Or, it can be expressed as the wilful manipulation of others, ruthlessness and an infatuation with power.



Pluto in Libra

Pluto was in Libra between 1971-1984. You were born at a time when more peace and arbitration was sought to try to avoid world-wide war.

3rd House

The 3rd house is naturally associated with the sign Gemini and its ruling planet Mercury.

After stabilising our self identity, and acquiring a sense of security in the 2nd, we need, in the 3rd house, to establish our relationship to our immediate environment. This house represents the area of experience concerned with communication and the exchange of information with our immediate social environment. It represents the activity of learning and the type and direction of intellectual and educational skills. On a more mundane level, the 3rd house is related to short journeys, immediate relatives, brothers and sisters if any, and their roles in our lives.



Pluto in 3rd House

The transforming and penetrating planet Pluto is in the 3rd House of your chart. You have a powerful urge to understand human motivations and drives, aware of the powerful self-creative and/or self-destructive urges that lie within all of us. Deep transformations within your own psyche may often change your perception of the world around you, or vice versa. At certain times in your life, powerful emotional crises may force you to change your perceptions of your familiar environment and your place in it. Pluto may often destroy your old way of seeing things as a prelude to a more profound and deeper state of understanding.

You are not satisfied with superficial or obvious solutions to problems, you are aware that there are deeper and more powerful emotions and motives underlying people's conduct, even when dealing with their everyday lives. You have the ability to create deep transformations in other people's perceptions of themselves and the world around them. Whether the effects of these changes, are positive or negative, creative or destructive, will depend on your own personal motivations. You will need to be aware of the old occult teaching that knowledge is power (you probably already are), but the greater the knowledge, the greater the responsibility, and the harder the universe will hit you if you abuse this responsibility.



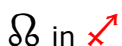
The Midheaven

Represents your ambitions and potential for achievement.



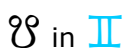
Midheaven in Aries
